*Please Note: Applicants are able to seek up to an additional 5% of its total eligible reimbursed claim to assist with Direct Administrative Costs (DAC) for claim preparation, submission, and management.

Based on latest FEMA guidance, COVID-19 related activities which will be considered eligible and likely reimbursed by FEMA include:

- Establishment of Organizational Emergency Operations Coordination Response Center and Related Costs;
- Increased Security Measures;
- Personal Protective Equipment and Hazardous Material Suits;
- Survey Safety Inspections and Disinfection of Healthcare Facilities;
- Repositioning of Emergency Related Resources;
- Establishment of Temporary Medical Facilities to Test, Isolate, and Treat Infected Persons;
- Non-Deferrable Medical Treatment of Infected Persons in a Shelter or Temporary Medical Facility;
- Emergency Medical Transport of Patients Among Facilities;
- Related Emergency Medical Facility Services and Supplies;
- Provision of Medical Goods, Supplies, and Services at the Request of Local Health Departments and Area Shelters:
- Use and Rental of Specialized Emergency Medical Equipment;
- Medical Waste Disposal in Accordance with Applicable Compliance Standards; and
- OT for Forced Account Labor Performing Emergency Protective Measures Outside of Customary Job Duty.

FEMA will not duplicate assistance provided by any other source.
